Their research focuses on the behavioural epidemiology of physical activity, particularly among children and young people. She has a strong interest in the role of the built and social environment in shaping active living, including active travel.

Professor Susanne Tittlbach is Professor for Social and Health Sciences in Sport at the Bayreuth Center of Sport Science (BaySpo) and Vice-President for Digitalization, Innovation, and Sustainability at the University of Bayreuth, Germany. Her team's research focuses on individual, social, and environmental conditions of physical activity. She has a strong interest in participatory intervention approaches for enhancing physical activity and active travel, as well as reducing sedentary behavior in different settings.
